

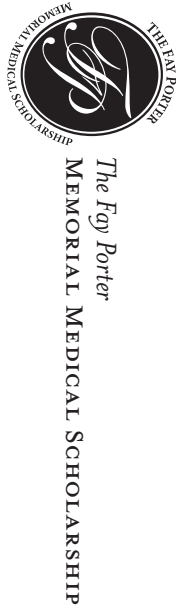
Williamson Medical Center FOUNDATION

The Fay Porter MEMORIAL MEDICAL SCHOLARSHIP

In 1995, Williamson Medical Center named a scholarship in memory of Fay Porter, a longtime friend and supporter of Williamson Medical Center. After moving to Franklin from Indianapolis in 1978, Fay discovered her favorite place to dine—the Medical Center’s cafeteria. In the cafeteria, this well-known and well-liked volunteer made many friends from each department. Fay comforted everyone around her, as she exhibited the compassion that is so vital to the healing process. Fay passed away at the Medical Center in November 1994 after a long battle with cancer.



Background Information

Scholarships are awarded annually to local students pursuing degrees in a health profession. The scholarship fund receives donations from Williamson Medical Center’s medical staff and employees as well as contributions from members of the community. The annual Williamson Medical Center Foundation Golf Tournament also benefits the scholarship.

Requirements

- Intended or current enrollment in a health care field of study
- Williamson County residence with special consideration given to those associated with WMC (i.e., junior volunteers, Explorer Post, dependent of WMC employee, etc.)

Applying for the Scholarship

- 1. Complete ENTRY FORM.**
Submit ENTRY FORM (on right) with required materials.
- 2. Write a one-page essay outlining your:**
 - Experience in health care, if any,
 - Educational and future health care goals, and
 - Reason for applying for the scholarship.
- 3. Make a list of your accomplishments.**
Include your awards, extracurricular activities, community involvement, etc.
- 4. Obtain two recommendations.**
One personal and one professional letter of recommendation are required. An instructor may provide a recommendation if the applicant is not employed in health care.
- 5. Provide copy of transcript.**
- 6. Return all materials by April 1.**
Mail the ENTRY FORM (address provided on the form) with the following items:
 - Essay
 - List of accomplishments
 - Letters of recommendation
 - Transcript
